The Planner Guide: An Organizational and Reference System for People with Social and Cognitive Challenges was designed by three professionals (an SLP, an educator and a special education teacher) who collectively have more than 90 years' experience working with individuals with special needs and ASD.

The well-designed product—which looks just like a day planner many of us carry—combines curriculum with planning and organization tools that can be used independently or in home/classroom environments. Useful tools include:

- an instruction manual for parents, teachers or other adults
- 9 color-coded sections: Personal, Problem-solving, Communication, Relationships, Community, Work, Home, School and Information.
- 141 Reference Guides step an individual through different common situations.
- 56 wallet-sized cards keep Reference information handy
- a portable, customizable monthly calendar

The Planner Guide is very visual-based, and curriculum modules incorporate time-tested strategies such as Social Stories, visual symbols, logic and problem-solving flowcharts and checklists. Not just for school students, *The Planner Guide* is a user-friendly life guide that can promote successful social independence.
